We heard the demand for an "advanced" and hyper competitive league but also recognized the need for a "novice plus" league - to date we have 120+ folks playing in our leagues (listed below)!

INTERMEDIATE

Sunday Evening

This is our most popular league and features more experienced players who know the game and understand the basics (dinking/resets/drop shots and serves in play etc.)

Roster size is 40+ players.

ADVANCED

Wednesday Evening

This is a very competitive league featuring some of the most skilled players at the Complex and geared to the 3.75+ player.

Roster size is 30+ players.

NOVICE PLUS

Thursday Afternoon

This league is geared to those looking for a friendly setting where you can continue to grow your interest in the game. The focus of the league will be spirited play, but you should at least know the basics of pickleball.

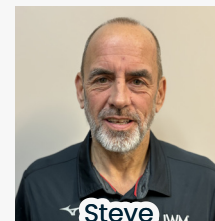
